The **Department of Electrical Engineering, University of South Florida**, invites applications for two Instructor positions scheduled to start in August, 2009 or sooner. The position is non-tenure track. Primary responsibility is teaching, although additional duties, including participation on committees, are required. Candidates are expected to have an educational background qualifying them to teach Electrical Engineering courses at the undergraduate and preferably graduate level. Preference will be given to applicants that have a Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering and teaching experience. Applications from candidates with educational and/or experience-based expertise in the department's research thrust areas such as Power and Energy, Wireless and Microwaves, and Biotechnology are strongly encouraged. One of these positions will teach extensively in the Power area.
